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La Route de Satipo, Pérou, du 16 au 27 novembre 2005. 12 jours et plus de 500 espèces!!!

Guides:

Gunnar Engblom. Vit au Pérou depuis 1998 mais y fait de l'ornitho depuis 1990. A observé plus de 1500 espèces dans ce pays.

Fabrice Schmitt. Fait de l'ornitho au Pérou depuis 1995. Esprit de découverte, guide et ornitho passionné. Vit désormais au Chili depuis 2005.

Introduction:

La route de Satipo est une destination ornitho encore très peu connue.

Pourtant la biodiversité que l'on rencontre le long de cette route est similaire, si ce n'est supérieure, à celle que l'on trouve sur la fameuse route de Manu dans le sud du Pérou. La preuve : nous avons réussi à contacter plus de 500 espèces en seulement 12 jours, en incluant une journée avant le tour aux Lomas de Lachay, et une virée en mer après le tour.

Cependant, personne n'a véritablement contacter ces 500 espèces. En effet, l'équipe s'est parfois divisé en deux groupes, et tout le monde n'a donc pas emprunté le même itinéraire. Les 503 espèces présentées dans ce rapport sont celles qui ont été contactées par l'ensemble des participants.

Mais tout le monde a vu au moins 400 espèces en seulement 11 jours - ce qui est déjà remarquable !!

Actuellement, Kolibri Expeditions débute un projet avec les communautés vivant le long de la route de Satipo afin de développer le secteur en destination éco-touristique. Ce voyage n'a pas été sans problèmes. Du brouillard à l'aéroport de Madrid a retardé 6 personnes et leurs bagages ne sont pas arrivés avec eux. Trois d'entre eux ont souffert encore plus, puisqu'ils n'ont retrouvé leur bagages que lors de leur arrivé à Lima, après le tour (la chute d'un pont entre Satipo et Lima rendant impossible l'envoi de leurs bagages arivés avec 5 jours de retard) !

Les 12 participants de ce tour ont eu 6 personnes pour s'occuper d'eux et 3 véhicules. Il s'agissait de Gunnar Engblom et Fabrice Schmitt comme guides ornitho, Julio et Adriano comme chauffeurs, et les frères Hidalgo Richard et Renzo comme aide de camp/chauffeur et cuisinier respectivement.

16 Nov. Lomas de Lachay (il s'agit d'une journée optionnelle).

Fabrice emmène 3 personnes qui sont soit arrivées plus tôt, soit qui avaient un jour de libre entre le tour précédent [Andes Centrales](#) et ce tour sur la route de Satipo.

Les espèces les plus intéressantes de cette sortie à la réserve des Lomas de Lachay ont été la Synallaxe des cactus (Cactus Canastero), les Géosittes du Pérou et à bec épais (Coastal and Thick-billed Miner), la Moucherolle à queue courte (Short-tailed Field-Tyrant), la Chouette des terriers (Burrowing Owl), la Buse aguia (Black-chested Buzzard-Eagle), le Faucon aplomado (Aplomado Falcon), le Toui à bandeau jaune (Mountain Parakeet), le Colibri vesper (Oasis Hummingbird), le Colibri fanny (Purple-collared Woodstar), le Colibri Cora (Peruvian Sheartail), le Phrygile à queue barrée (Band-tailed Sierra-Finch), le Chipiu à col noir (Collared Warbling-Finch), la Sicale de Raimondi (Raimondi's Yellow-Finch) et le Thinocore de Patagonie (Least Seedsnipe).

Une boucle aux lagunes de Paraiso nous a permis de trouver quelques pluviers oréophiles (Tawny-throated Dotterel), des flamants du Chili (Chilean Flamingo), 3 sarcelles à ailes bleues (Blue-winged Teal), 1 faucon pèlerin (Peregrine), quelques pipits jaunâtres (Yellowish Pipit) et bien d'autres.

Dans l'après-midi, nous apprenons que 6 participants arriveront en retard en raison de brouillard sur l'aéroport de Madrid.

17 Nov. Milieux côtiers proches de Lima

Les 6 participants déjà présents à Lima partent avec un guide local Alejandro Tello et Adriano à Pucusana et Puerto Viejo. Ils y trouveront l'Oedicnème du Pérou (Peruvian Thick-knee), le Manchot de Humboldt (Humboldt Penguin), l'Huîtrier noir (Blackish Oystercatcher) et le superbe Tyranneau omnicolore (Many-colored Rush-Tyrant).

Les 6 participants retardés arriveront à l'aéroport de Lima dans l'après-midi sans leurs bagages. Fabrice les emmènera aux Pantanos de Villa où en plus d'un grand nombre de laridés, de hérons et de canards ils observeront une foulque à jarretières (Red-gartered Coot; cet individu constitue la première mention pour le Pérou), et les espèces intéressantes suivantes : Canard des Bahamas (White-cheeked Pintail), Buse de Harris (Harris Hawk), Faucon pèlerin (Peregrine), Oedicnème du Pérou (Peruvian Thick-knee), Synallaxe troglodyte (Wren-like Rushbird) et le Tyranneau omnicolore (Many-colored Rush-tyrant).

Après le dîner, l'ensemble de l'équipe embarque dans un confortable bus de nuit en direction de San Ramon.

18 Nov. San Ramon-Pampa Hermosa.

Il pleut lorsque nous arrivons à San Ramon. Nous prenons notre petit-déjeuner dans un restaurant proche. Pendant que certains s'attardent à table, ceux qui n'ont pas leurs bagages vont au marché pour acheter quelques habits de secours. Après cela, on commence à chercher quelques oiseaux de l'autre côté de la rivière de San Ramon.

Il s'agit d'une introduction pour les espèces commune de l'Amazonie telles que Tangara évêque et des palmiers (Blue-Gray et Palm Tanager), Tangara à bec d'argent (Silver-beaked Tanager), Tyran mélancolique (Tropical Kingbird), Troglodyte familier (Southern House Wren), Ortalide maillée (Speckled Chachalaca), Merle à bec noir (Black-billed Thrush), Cassique cul-jaune (Yellow-rumped Casique), Cacique roussâtre (Russet-backed Oropendula) etc, mais rapidement quelques espèces plus intéressantes apparaissent.

Nous ferons quelques arrêts sur le chemin du lodge de Pampa Hermosa ce qui permettra de rajouter l'Alapi à sourcils blancs (White-browed Antbird), le Foothill Warbling Antbird (ssp *subflava* de l'Alapi carillonneur - Warbling Antbird), le Toucanet de Derby (Chestnut-tipped Toucanet) et le Myrmidon à ventre blanc (Stripe-chested Antwren).

Le repas de midi est pris dans ce lodge fabuleux, au milieu de nulle part et au bout d'une très mauvaise route, à 1250 m. d'altitude. Là, nous avons le choix entre une marche jusqu'au plateau de Pampa Hermosa, ou de nous relaxer et d'aller visiter une arène de Coq-de-roche péruvien (Andean Cock-of-the Rock).

Tout le monde décide d'aller en forêt. Le chemin est étroit et boueux, mais nous sommes récompensés par quelques superbes observations d'espèces qui ne seront plus contactées durant le tour, telles que l'énorme Pic superbe (Crimson-bellied Woodpecker) et quelques singes capucins (Capuchin monkeys). Quelques personnes décident de retourner au lodge via l'arène de Coq-de-roche. Ceux qui poursuivent la randonnée ne verront pas beaucoup d'espèces, même si certaines sont entendus très près, telles que le Troglodyte ferrugineux (Chestnut-breasted Wren) et le Tétéma flambé (Short-tailed Antthrush). Mais nous ferons une belle observation de Barbacou à front blanc (White-fronted Nunbird), ainsi que d'une grosse troupe de Singe laineux (Wholly Monkeys). Même si cette balade ne nous aura pas permis de rencontrer énormément d'espèces d'oiseaux, découvrir cette forêt humide de montagne, totalement vierge, est toujours une expérience sensationnelle. Les plus gros arbres rencontrés aujourd'hui avaient des diamètres proches de 5 m. Après un excellent repas du soir, on se couche très tôt.

19 Nov. Pampa Hermosa Lodge - San Ramon

Un peu de pluie au réveil, ce qui ne nous empêche pas de faire un peu d'ornitho avant le petit-

déjeuner. On passe par l'arène de Coq-de-roche. Après le petit-déjeuner, il pleut de nouveau, puis le soleil réapparaît, signe qu'il faut retourner sur le terrain !

On redescend doucement vers San Ramon, et tandis que Julio prépare le repas de midi, on découvre quelques bandes constituées de plusieurs espèces. L'observation des oiseaux en forêt est généralement difficile, et pour cela, prospecter le long des pistes comme celle-ci, traversant parfois les plantations de café, de fruit et d'avocat, est souvent très productif. Les meilleures espèces de la journée auront été : Elanion naucleur (Swallow-tailed Kite), Motmot d'Equateur (Highland Motmot), Jacamar à couronne bleue (Bluish-fronted Jacamar), Araçari à oreillons roux (Chestnut-eared Aracari), Picumne d'Orbigny (Ocellated Piculet), Synallaxe à sourcils gris (Ash-browed Spinetail), Sittine striée (Streaked Xenops), Manakin à queue ronde (Round-tailed Manakin), Microtyran à ventre blanc (White-bellied Pygmy-Tyrant), Tyran à sourcils jaunes (Lemon-

browed Flycatcher), Tityre masqué (Masked Tityra), Bécarde à ailes blanches (White-winged Becard), Cincle à tête blanche (White-capped Dipper) et Guit-guit céruléen (Purple Honeycreeper). Une partie du groupe observera un Faucon orangé (Orange-breasted Falcon). On arrive à San Ramon après de nombreux arrêts, et on passera la nuit dans un hôtel calme et agréable, en périphérie de la ville.

20 Nov. San Ramon-Oxapampa road-Pichanaki

On fait quelques observations dans le jardin de l'hôtel avant le petit-déjeuner. Que des espèces communes, mais toutes nouvelles pour le groupe. On poursuit ensuite sur les terrains d'un lodge en périphérie de San Ramon, où on longe une petite rivière en forêt jusqu'à une cascade. On observe quelques papillons *Morpho* et une grive de Swainson.

De retour à la clairière, on observe 1 tyranneau minute (White-lored Tyrannulet), 1 troglodyte Coraya (Coraya Wren) et des hirondelles à ceinture blanche (White-banded Swallow).

Le troisième véhicule nous rejoint avec l'équipe intendance et Fabrice. Fabrice revient d'un tour réalisé pour Naturetrek et qui s'est fini dans la vallée de la Santa Eulalia durant notre première journée à Pampa Hermosa.

Fabrice trouve presque immédiatement un aigle noir et blanc (Black-and-White Hawk Eagle) dans un thermique avec quelques dizaines d'Urubu.

Nous avons le reste de la journée pour rejoindre Pichanaki, et faire un petit détour sur la route d'Oxapampa où nous prendrons notre repas de midi. La route est en mauvais état mais ce fût un bon choix puisque nous trouverons 1 barbacou lancéolé (Lanceolated Monklet), 1 rare moucherolle noirâtre (Blackish Pewee) et de nombreuses autres espèces.

Nous avons prévu de chercher l'Engoulevent sable en soirée à Pichanaki, mais une averse nous empêche de faire de belles observations. Nous retenterons notre chance le lendemain au port de Pichanaki.

L'hôtel est basique. Il y a de l'eau chaude.... parfois ! Nous avons beau réserver, mais quand nous arrivons, il n'y a pas de serviettes, de savon et de papier toilette dans les chambres. Gunnar et Fabrice courent dans tous les sens pour préparer les chambres... il ne faut pas espérer trouver d'hôtels très convenables sur la route de Satipo !

Mais d'un autre côté, c'est aussi ce qui fait le charme de ce voyage : on est loin des routes touristiques classiques, et on a le sentiment d'être les premiers à venir dans le secteur. Si le nombre de touristes qui visitent cette région augmentaient, la qualité du service suivrait sans aucun doute. Et plus le tourisme nature se développera dans la région, plus il y aura de chance de voir les oiseaux et les habitats protégés.

Nous mangeons quelques poissons grillés au bord de la rivière... et la bière de ce soir aura rarement été aussi bonne !

21 Nov. Pichanaki-Yurinaki-Satipo-Apaya.

Comme prévu, nous faisons d'excellentes observations d'Engoulevent sable dans la matinée, en compagnie de Bec-en-ciseaux noir (Black Skimmer). Nous quittons Yurinaki pour prendre notre petit déjeuner au bord de la rivière. Pendant que Renzo nous prépare un somptueux petit déjeuner, nous découvrons plus de 30 espèces d'oiseaux en très peu de temps : Dormilon fluviatile (Little Ground-Tyrant), Todirostre à front roux (Rusty-fronted Tody-Flycatcher), Moucherolle des aulnes (Alder Flycatcher; identifié plus tard à partir de l'enregistrement de son cri), Onoré fascié (Fasciated Tiger-Heron), Pionne à tête bleue (Blue-headed Parrot), Conure pavouane (White-eyed Parakeet) et Araçari à oreillons roux (Chestnut-eared Aracari).

Après le petit-déjeuner, nous nous rendons à Satipo. Il fait très chaud aujourd'hui, et nous n'observons rien de particulier sur le trajet. Nous passons une heure à Satipo. Fabrice aide ceux qui n'ont malheureusement toujours pas récupéré leurs bagages. Certains en profiteront pour aller sur Internet - dernière possibilité pour les 5 prochains jours - et d'autres pour manger une glace. Hors de Satipo nous faisons des arrêts réguliers avant et après le repas de midi que nous prendrons en cours de route, ce qui nous permet de contacter : Buse à queue courte (Short-tailed Hawk), Cabézon à poitrine d'or (Lemon-throated Barbet), Pic à chevron d'or (Yellow-tufted Woodpecker), Sourciroux mélodieux (Rufous-browed Peppershrike), Picumne de Lafresnaye (Lafresney's Piculet), Milan bleuâtre (Plumbeous Kite), Campyloptère à ventre gris (Gray-breasted Sabrewing) et Synallaxe à gorge blanche (Dark-breasted Spinetail).

Nous avions prévu de passer la nuit vers 1300-1500m d'altitude aujourd'hui, mais malheureusement l'endroit où nous voulions camper est désormais traversé par une route de fortune qui permet de contourner un pont hors d'usage !

Nous camperons donc au village d'Apaya.

Le camp est prêt, ainsi que le repas du soir, lorsque nous arrivons. Les tentes sont posées près d'une école que nous utiliserons en soirée comme camp de base.

22 Nov. Prospection de la partie basse de la route, section Apaya-Mariposa et retour

Journée parfaite avec énormément d'oiseaux. Nous prospectons essentiellement la zone subtropicale sous Apaya. Plus de 100 espèces sont trouvées aujourd'hui. Onoré fascié (Fasciated Tiger-Heron), Merganette des torrents (Torrent Duck), Coracine ornée (Amazonian Umbrellabird), Caurale soleil (Sunbittern), Quetzal doré et antisien (Golden-headed and Crested Quetzals), Trogon masqué (Masked Trogon), Colibri porte-épée (Sword-billed Hummingbird), Cabézon élégant (Versicolored Barbet), Perceflor glauque (Deep-blue Flowerpiercer), de nombreuses espèces de tangaras, Aigle d'Isidor (Black-and-Chestnut Eagle), Buse solitaire (Solitary eagle) et un tout récent split de l'Inca à collier ("Peruvian Inca", split from collared Inca) entre autres.

23 Nov. Une moitié du groupe prospecte la partie haute de la route, jusqu'à Manzanilla, tandis que le reste du groupe prospecte de nouveau la partie basse, jusqu'à Mariposa.

Une partie du groupe désire prospecter la partie haute de la route, bien qu'il y ait plus d'oiseaux à voir sur la partie basse. Aucun problème, on divise le groupe. 6 personnes vont avec Fabrice sur la partie haute, et les 6 autres sur la partie basse avec Gunnar.

A la fin de la journée, tout le monde est content de son choix respectif. Impeccable !!

Le groupe qui est monté a observé presque toutes les espèces dont le nom commun se termine par "des Andes" (vanneau, mouette, ouette, éristature, etc...) ainsi que la Métallure à gorge feu (Fiery-throated Metaltail), la Synallaxe à lunettes (Eye-ringed Thistletail), la forme *obscura* de la Grallaire rousse (Rufous Antpitta) et un groupe de 12 conures à pinceaux d'or (Golden-plumed Parakeet).

La journée aura été agréable et très ensoleillée (un peu trop pour certains qui reviendront rouges de la balade !), et a permis la découverte de paysages andins absolument somptueux - quel contraste avec la journée d'hier !

Le groupe du bas a eu quelques espèces qui ne seront plus observées par la suite : Tohi à nuque rousse (Chestnut-capped Brush-Finch), Colibri à tête violette (Violet-headed Hummingbird), Elénie à ventre jaune (Yellow-bellied Elaenia), Tyran pirate (Piratic Flycatcher), Picumne de Cusco (Fine-barré Piculet), un split du Toucanet émeraude (Black-throated (Andean) Toucanet), Alapi fuligineux (Sooty Antbird), Paruline triline (Three-striped Warbler) et Tyranneau plombé (Plumbeous-crowned Tyrannulet)... et observerons également : Tangara à bavette jaune (Yellow-throated Tanager), Grisin noirâtre (Blackish Antbird), Mérulaxe de Bolivie (Bolivian Tapaculo), Tangara à flancs roux (Rufous-chested Tanager), Tangara barbouillé (Black-eared Hemispingus), Solitaire des Andes (Andean Solitaire) et Tohi tricolore (Tricolored Brush-Finch).

Le groupe du bas prendra le repas de midi au campement, et prospectera la partie haute de la route dans l'après-midi, comme prévu. Une très bonne après-midi avec de nombreux groupes mixtes. Les meilleures espèces de l'après-midi seront : Mérulaxe à ventre roux (Rufous-vented Tapaculo), Trogon masqué (Masked Trogon), Hirondelle de Chapman (Pale-footed Swallow), Tangara à ventre rouge (Scarlet-bellied Mountain-Tanager), Moucherolle à gorge rayée (Streak-throated Bush-Tyrant), Calliste à nuque d'or (Golden-naped Tanager), Cotinga à huppe rouge (Red-crested Cotinga), Tangara de Reinhardt (Yellow-scarfed Tanager), Héliange gorge améthyste (Amethyst-throated Sunangel), Cotinga barré (Barred Fruiteater), Troglodyte brun (Peruvian Wren), Anabate de Boissonneaux (Streaked Tuftedcheek), Synallaxe roux (Rufous Spinetail) et Anabassite perlée (Pearled Treerunner).

A Carrizales, le groupe de Gunnar rejoint celui de Fabrice et rajoute également la Métallure à gorge feu (Fiery-throated Metaltail). Le retour à la tombée de la nuit sera très productif et permettra d'excellentes observations d'Engoulevent à queue d'aronde (Swallow-tailed Nightjar) et de Chouette fasciée (Rufous-banded Owl). Un engoulevent à miroir (Band-winged Nightjar) sera également observé rapidement.

24 Nov. Division du groupe : certains vont à Andamarca, d'autres restent sur la route de Satipo.

Lorsque nous visitons la route de Satipo, nous faisons souvent un crochet à Punto pour chercher le Tohi à lunettes noires (Black-spectacled Brush-Finch) récemment décrit et une nouvelle espèce de troglodyte du genre *Thryothorus* découverte par Gunnar. Toutefois, cela implique un campement à très haute altitude et une marche difficile de plus de 450 m. de dénivellation. Cette marche n'est pas très populaire, et particulièrement auprès de ceux qui ont raté le Tohi...

Il est décidé de ne pas aller à Punto et de tenter notre chance dans le secteur d'Andamarca. Après tout il s'agit du même bassin versant, et il n'y a pas de raisons pour que toutes les espèces intéressantes ne soient pas présentes autour d'Andamarca, même si Gunnar n'y a pas trouvé le Tohi lors d'une visite en 2000.

Tout le monde a le choix, soit d'aller à Andamarca avec Gunnar, soit de rester sur la route de Satipo avec Fabrice.

Nous commençons la journée ensemble, et la matinée commence très bien avec un peu de playback qui permet à tout le monde d'observer 1 grisin à longue queue (Long-tailed Antbird), 1 alapi à dos blanc (White-backed Fire-eye) et 1 mérulaxe à ventre roux (Rufous-vented Tapaculo). En continuant notre route, nous rencontrons de nombreuses bandes de passereaux avec plusieurs tangaras de Rieffer et autres tangaras multicolore. Mais il se met à pleuvoir de manière continue... on retourne alors au campement où nous prendrons le repas de midi.

Après le repas, les deux groupes se divisent. Le groupe 1 commence son ascension vers Andamarca. Rapidement, la plupart des espèces observées la veille par le groupe "du haut" sont retrouvées, y compris les perruches à pinces d'or (Golden-plumed Parakeet) et la Synallaxe à lunettes (Eye-ringed Thistletail). Gunnar découvre un groupe de Pardusco d'O'Neill (Pardusco) : une nouvelle espèce pour le département de Junin et une extension d'aire de répartition de plus de 240 km !

En traversant la puna, nous observons de nombreuses espèces typiques de cet habitat : Vanneau des Andes (Andean Lapwing), Pic des rochers (Andean Flicker), Olette des Andes (Andean Goose),

Mouette des Andes (Andean Gull), Caracara montagnard (Mountain Caracara), etc... Près du passage de plus élevé, à 4000 m. d'altitude, nous observons 1 mérulaxe "de Millpo" (espèce non décrite), 1 grallaire des Andes et 1 synallaxe très étrange ressemblant beaucoup à un Synallaxe flammé (Many-striped Canastero). Lorsque nous descendons dans la vallée d'Andamarca, presque tout le groupe observe la forme *obscura* de la Grallaire rousse (Rufous Antpitta). De nombreux lamas remontent la piste - lamas qui sont encore, dans cette région, utilisés comme animaux de trait comme à l'époque des Incas, ce qui est de plus en plus rare au Pérou actuellement.

Nous nous installons dans le plus basique des hôtels jamais essayé ! Une expérience que l'on est pas prêt d'oublier. Imaginez une épicerie, un restaurant, une cuisine, un élevage de cochon d'Inde, un grossiste en bière et un hôtel dans le même édifice. Les chambres n'étaient séparées que par une très fine cloison en planche, et la hauteur des portes ne dépassait pas 160 cm. Les chambres étaient décorées par des calendriers avec des femmes à moitié nue ou des paysages alpins faisant la promotion pour des marques de bière, d'huile de moteur ou de logiciel informatique. On était très loin des standards de "bed and breakfast" européen !!

Pendant ce temps, après 3 heures de forte pluie ininterrompue, le groupe que est resté à Apaya, prospecte la partie basse de la piste.

Les espèces observées cette après-midi incluent le Calliste à sourcils bleus (Blue-browed Tanager), le Toucanet à ceinture bleue (Blue-banded Toucanet), 1 adulte d'Aigle d'Isidor (Black-and-Chestnut Eagle), 1 faucon orangé (Orange-breasted Falcon), un groupe de Grisin noirâtre (Blackish Antbird), la Coracine ornée (Amazonian Umbrellabird), et quelques moucherolles hirondelle (Cliff Flycatcher) parmi tant d'autres...

25 Nov. Groupe 1: Andamarca-La Oroya.

A Andamarca, on apprend que la nouvelle route entre Pariahuanca et Huancayo n'est toujours pas terminée. Nous serons donc obligé de revenir en arrière pour rejoindre la route de Satipo. Toutefois, une partie de la route est construite, et les gens que nous rencontrons nous disent qu'il reste quelques lambeaux de forêt. Nous avons vraiment trop peu de temps pour faire une bonne prospection du secteur mais nous rajoutons tout de même quelques espèces à notre liste, dont la Synallaxe "de Mantaro" ("Mantaro" Thornbird) pas encore décrite et qui ne serait présent que dans le bassin versant du Mantaro.

Lors du trajet retour vers la route principale, on recherche le Tohi et il est vu par certains. Tout le monde observe la forme *obscura* de la Grallaire rousse ("Fulvous" Antpitta). Et un peu plus loin, Gunnar entend la nouvelle espèce de troglodyte de genre *Thryothorus*. L'ensemble du groupe monte alors le versant jusqu'à une touffe de bambou, et observe à quelques mètres cet oiseau qui n'a toujours pas de nom officiel.

Il se fait tard, et il reste une longue route à effectuer. Nous ne ferons plus que très peu d'arrêts, qui produiront tout le même quelques ibis à face noire (Andean Ibis) et un tinamou de Taczanowski (Taczanowski's Tinamou) qui traverse la route. A 19h30 nous prenons un bon repas dans un restaurant au bord de la route principale qui relie Huancayo à La Oroya, et nous actualisons notre checklist.

On arrive à La Oroya juste après 22h. Une grande et longue, mais mémorable journée : nous avons vu une espèce récemment décrite, et 3 espèces qui n'ont toujours pas de nom officiel.

Groupe 2: Apaya-Carrizales-Lago Pomacocha-La Oroya

On prospecte la piste au-dessus d'Apaya tandis que l'équipe de Kolibri démonte le campement. On trouve quelques très bons groupes ce matin, avec notamment 1 adulte perché de Buse cul-blanc (White-rumped Hawk), 3 colibris porte-épée (Sword-billed Hummingbird), une superbe observation de Grallaire châtaine (Bay Antpitta), 3 espèces d'*Hemispingus* (Tangara à menton orangé, grisâtre et barbouillé : White-browed, White-bellied, Black-eared Hemispingus), Tangara de Reinhardt (Yellow-scarfed Tanager), Calliste béryl (Beryl-spangled Tanager), etc...

Lorsque le minibus de Kolibri nous rejoint, on va directement à Carrizales où l'on trouve assez rapidement 1 grallaire rousse de la sous-espèce *obscura* ("Fulvous" Antpitta), la Synallaxe à lunettes (Eye-ringed Thistletail) et le Cincle à tête blanche (White-capped Dipper).

Plus tard, on s'arrêtera à Manzanilla, où l'Upucerthie striée est assez commune. On y fait également une superbe observation de Grallaire des Andes (Stripe-headed Antpita), notre troisième observation de Grallaire aujourd'hui !!, ainsi que de Colibri à ailes saphir (Great Sapphirewing), de Chardonneret noir (Black Siskin), et de la star du secteur, la Mérullaxe de "Millpo" !

Il nous reste aussi une longue route jusqu'à La Oroya, mais quelques arrêts nous permettront d'observer la Buse tricolore (Red-backed Hawk) ou le Flamant du Chili (Chilean Flamingo).

26 Nov. La Oroya-Ticlio-vallée de Santa Eulalia-Lima

Le groupe redescend des Andes jusqu'à Lima, en passant par la vallée de Santa Eulalia. On commence par prospecter la tourbière de Ticlio à 4600 m. d'altitude où l'on observe quelques cinclodes à ventre blanc (White-bellied Cinclodes), 4 attagis de Gay (Rufous-bellied Seedsnipe), quelques bécassines du Puna (Puna Snipe), 1 métallure olivâtre (Olivaceous Thornbill) et une des espèces phares du voyage : 2 pluviers des Andes (Diademed Sandpiper-plover) !

Les arrêts suivants en redescendant la vallée de Santa Eulalia produiront la Synallaxe de Junin (Junin Canastero), l'Upucerthie de Jelski (Plain-breasted Earthcreeper), le Colibri à plastron noir (Black-breasted Hillstar) et la Géositte andine (Dark-winged Miner).

Les paysages dans la vallée de Santa Eulalia sont magnifiques, et nous découvrons nos 3 premiers condors des Andes (Andean Condor) près d'un bois de *Polylepis* (nous observerons 5 autres condors dans l'après-midi, au niveau d'un dortoir). Près de ce bois, nous trouverons également le Métallure phébé (Black Metalltail), le Synallaxe couronné (Rusty-crowned Tit-spinetail), le Synallaxe des canyons (Canyon Canastero), le Tohi à ventre roux (Rusty-bellied Brush-finch) et une partie du groupe observera le Conirostre géant (Giant Conebill).

Nous ferons notre dernier arrêt près du pont de San Pedro où nous trouverons 1 chevêchette du Pérou (Peruvian Pygmy-owl), quelques colibri de Boursier (Bronze-tailed Comet), 2 pics à cou noir (Black-necked Woodpecker), quelques Chipiu à col noir (Collared Warbling-finch) et quiscales buissonnier (Scrub Blackbird).



La vallée Santa Eulalia (Gunnar Engblom)

27 Nov. Sortie pélagique depuis Lima.

Un très bonne sortie en mer ! On observe d'énormes groupes de mouettes de Franklin (Franklin's Gulls) autour des bateaux pêchant les anchois. Nous faisons également de belles observations d'Albatros des Galapagos (Waved Albatross) et de nombreuses autres espèces pélagiques. Lors du trajet retour, on passe près des îles Palomino où se reproduisent plus de 2000 lions de mer (sea-lion). Les derniers restes de poissons que nous avons utilisé pour attirer pétrels et puffins, seront jetés aux nombreuses sternes inca (Inca Terns), qui, dans la lumière du soir, nous offriront un superbe spectacle pour clore ce voyage.

Dans l'ensemble, le voyage aura été une réussite, et un très bon rapport qualité-prix ! Un peu dur et fatigant parfois en raison de tout ce temps passé sur le terrain - mais une grande expérience.
